## **ELIGIBILITY**

The applicant may be a student graduating from a high school of the Baltimore County Public Schools, OR

The applicant may be a student graduating from any high school -- public, private, or parochial; in or out of county -- **and** have at least one parent who is a full-time employee of the Baltimore County Public Schools. This parent employee need not be a classroom teacher. The parent may be a secretary, cafeteria worker, custodian, bus driver, etc., but **must** be a full-time employee of the Baltimore County Public Schools.

- Letter(s) of Recommendation from a school or community source
- Career goals essay

- Description of awards/honors (if any)

Also by **February 22, 2013**, have the following documents sent to the address above from your high school Registrar. Your school will require a signed Release of Information form from you and/or your parent or legal guardian.

- An official copy of your high school transcript
- An official copy of your first semester senior year report card
- A copy of your SAT or ACT scores

Please use additional sheets to include any information you feel will help the committee make a fair and equitable decision to award our scholarships to truly deserving young people.
